

# **Sample Set List – Ceilidh for Teens**

*All non-gendered*

**Circassian Circle** – with extra cheering; can be done in 3s so all are included; use 1s and 2s for A2

**Falling Masonry** – highlight the ‘bump’ in A2, lots of galloping

**Holmfirth Square**

**Clopton Bridge** – identify 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> corners in walkthrough

**Wring Out The Dishrag** – mixer, with fun challenge in the ‘dishrag’ part

**Riverside Jig/Yarmouth Long Dance Remix** – arches in B2 to charge down to the end of the set

**break**

**Hazel’s Jig** (by Tony Slinger) – including battle cries in B1+2

**Military Two Step** – polka in pairs; either person can ‘twirl’ under  
Or **Muffin Man Jig**

**Virginia Reel**

**Balance The Star** – with do-si-dos in B1 and arches in B2

**Heaps** – with the option to move to a different set in A1+2

**Strip The Willow** – Orcadian style
